RAISING AWARENESS



Red panda conservation outreach has reached more than **100,000 people** living in red panda range.



5,000 students in Eastern Nepal celebrate International Red Panda Day (IRPD) every year.

PROTECTING RED PANDAS & THEIR HABITAT



Our conservation programs extend to over **50% of Nepal's red panda population**



and range in **388,100 hectares of forest.**
(that's nearly 1 million acres!)

National forest Guardian team has **73 members** who monitor red panda habitat throughout the year.



Conducted the **1st national survey** of red panda population and habitat in Nepal.



NURTURING AN ECOSYSTEM



Planted **18,000 native seedlings**
(all food sources for red pandas!)

Established **10 forest nurseries**



Restored **1,800 acres** of degraded forest.



Our nurseries have produced close to **100,000 saplings** of non-timber forest products

ANTI POACHING EFFORTS

Nearly 150 local people trained in anti-poaching investigation who have patrolled 309 km of red panda habitat.

65% reduction in trap/snare presence in patrolled areas since 2015
